Project Scope:

Parking lot replacement consisted of removing old sidewalks and door stoops to accept new sidewalks. Valley pans and concrete paving to improving draining for teacher parking lot. Installed retaining wall and handicap ramp with handrails along the baseball field and auxiliary gym. Security upgrades involved remodeling the main office to create controlled access into the main building, miscellaneous exterior door replacements, first responder signage, enhanced site lighting and adding window film.
